IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO UNDERSTAND THE TUITION

- One year of fulltime course work covers 8 courses. Students paying for the year cover four courses in each semester = to Eight (8) courses for the year.
- A Semester is four months. There are two semesters in the Academic year.
- Students wishing to reduce their years of study must take courses in the Summer running from May 1 – June 5
 - e.g. If you start in September of 2012, first year finishes April (Sep- Dec and Jan-Apr are the two semesters). Students taking summer classes will start year two May 2013 and complete the second year by December 2013.
 - e.g. if you enter Colbourne Jan 2013 and take summer classes your first year will be completed July 2013. September of 2013 you will be entering second year.
- New students are also accepted in the summer period starting May- July.
